### Cockatoo Island - self-guided tour

#### 12.55pm

Wharf number 5 Circular Quay, Sydney Ferries. Abbotsford service Includes Cockatoo Island Note: individual ferry tickets need to be purchased

Near the wharf at Cockatoo Island the Muster Café serves inexpensive light meals (no dish over \$12) 8.30am – 4pm. There is a steep walk to the top of the island where "Biloela" will be opened for family members – although not restored. This is the stone house where Charles Jnr (William's grandson) lived with his family when he was Sheriff of New South Wales between 1874 and 1896

Return to Circular Quay by ferry leaving the island at 2.55pm or 3.55pm
